DIRECTOR APPOINTMENTS

We are pleased to advise new directors have now been appointed to the board. Ross Lehmann and Gary Wenzel will continue in their previous roles on the board and are joined by our new directors Rebecca Wallbank & Roseanne Griffiths. We thank outgoing director Robert Kliese for 17 years continuous service with the board.

DROUGHT CONDITIONS

We encourage ratepayers to continue using water wisely and remain aware of low water levels currently in Moogerah Dam. Using water for essential use will help preserve local water storages.

TANK STORAGE

We strongly recommend customers have their own tanks or some form of onsite water storage for rural water. Onsite water storage helps avoid loss of supply during breakages or maintenance. It can be several days without supply after we identify or are advised of an issue and the subsequent organising of contractors for repair works.

METER SITE & REPAIRS

We ask our customers to keep their meter site clear from bushes to enable easy access for meter reading. Ratepayers are responsible for all pipe work exiting the meter, including installation and any repairs.

RATES AND CHARGES

The rates and charges for water supplied are listed on the attached rates and charges schedule. There has been no change to the rates and charges since 1 July 2016.

SALE OF PROPERTY

Please make sure you advise your solicitor when selling your property to contact Roadvale Water for a special meter read so adjustments can be made to the settlement as per Council Rates adjustments.

WATER ALLOCATION

Your bill outlines your actual water usage. The attached rates and charges schedule outline your allocation – for land up to 20 hectares 100KL per six-month billing period and for land over 20 hectares 5KL per hectare per six-month billing period. Note the special allocation for pensioners outlined next.

PENSIONER ALLOCATION

A concession is available for aged pensioners who can take advantage of an allocation of 25 kilolitres each half year. If a pensioner limits usage of water to this amount they will have a water charge of \$45 per six months or \$90 per year. Water used over this allocation will be charged at \$1.80 per kilolitre. The pensioner must own and reside at the property and be able to demonstrate they have a current valid Australian Government pension card. To apply for the pensioner allocation please contact Melinda for an application form.

WATER BREAKS

Water leaks are unavoidable in a water supply system. The Board employs part-time staff to manage breaks. As a Board we rely on the ratepayers to make us aware of water breaks. Please contact Tony, Melinda or a Board Member if you are aware of a water leak. Please note that any breaks that occur between your meter and onto your own property are your responsibility and these breaks can be very costly, up to \$1,200 per month.

TAMPERING WITH METERS

Please be advised it is an offence to tamper with water meter connections and penalties may apply. In the event of water supply issues please contact a member of the Board or our Maintenance Officer, Tony, to rectify issues.
